REPORTS

1. Chairman (Peter Brown)

The Chairman thanked the Committee for their hard work in ensuring that the 2022 / 23 season had got off to a successful start and wished everyone a success season. Hopes were recorded for a better season with regards to discipline matters both on and off the field of play by all concerned with the league.

2. General Secretary (Jonathan Brown)

a) AM Referee Appointments Update (Steve Chamberlain)

Mt Chamberlain reported that there had been a good start to the season, with some encouraging coverage for early in the season. Traditionally the month of September have proven to be challenging, but coverage had been good, although Leighton Buzzard still remains a challenging area (referees have a choice of the CYFL or the MKDDL to officiate in due to location), while some of the wider afield locations such as Bedwell and Potton are also more limited in terms of coverage options.

There have been some disappointing behavioural and discipline issues in the younger age groups, with red cards being necessary in some games in the Under 12 age group.

The Bedfordshire Football Association are hosting another new referees' course in October which will hopefully provide some more new referees.

b) PM Referee Appointments Update (Brian Cooper)

Mr Cooper reported that he had managed to appoint a referee to 100% of his allotted games for far this season, although there had been 2 games where the referee had pulled out at short notice (due to sickness on the day). Although both games had been played with a volunteer official standing in (as per league rules), both games had reported discipline issues, which is disappointing to hear.

6. Treasurer (Jane Brown)

However, the Treasurer asked clubs to ensure prompt payment of pitch fees and fines when they are issued, to avoid unnecessary work and additional fines being levied if payment is not received in a timely manner.
