REPORTS

Chairman (Peter Brown)

The Chairman expressed his concern at the length of time it was taking to get feedback from the County FA on referred matters, disciplinary cases and abandoned matches. This was proving frustrating for the Committee and also member clubs, some of whom had directed their frustrations towards the CYFL for the delay in reaching conclusions to outstanding matters.

2. General Secretary (Jonathan Brown)

Withdrawn Teams / Clubs

The following teams have unfortunately withdrawn from the CYFL during January:-

Hitchin Town Youth Orlandoes Under 18 (04/01/23)

As the team had only played 50% of their fixtures (11 out of 22 league games), their playing record would be expunged (as per League Rule 11(D)).

The committee agreed that the deposit for the above team would be with-held in lieu of a fine for the withdrawal, as per rule 11(A).

Rule Changes

The Committee discussed some potential areas for rule changes for the 2023 / 24 season The areas for discussion were:-

- **Teamsheets** The Committee felt that although this raised the standard of the league and would certainly be a useful deterrent for teams attempting to field unregistered players, there would not be universal support for re-introducing these from member clubs (based on previous feedback)
- Free Sundays the Committee felt that unless raised my member clubs, the current rule was sufficient, although teams should take more responsibility for planning around half term holidays to avoid issues.
- **RESPECT Barriers** it was agreed that the League would support the County FA's scheme for tightening guidance around usage of these at all matches.

3. Fixture Secretary (Tony Gee)

Fixture Updates

Mr. Gee advised that although things were progressing well with regards to the scheduling of fixtures, there was some concerns over the recent loss of fixtures due to the inclement weather and also the Festive Period.

• County Cup Fixtures

As per previous notes in these minutes, the Committee expressed their concerns at the poor level of administration and communication of County Cup fixtures this season.

• Committee Pitch Walking (report as supplied by John Thomas)

Mr. Thomas discussed a number of requests that had been received from clubs asking for CYFL Committee representation to attend forthcoming fixtures. The Committee reviewed these requests and assigned representatives to attend all fixtures and observe behaviours and conduct player ID checks.

4. Players Registrations Secretary (Emma Vase)

The Player Registration Secretary provided the below summary to illustrate the position at the time of the meeting.

a) AM Referee Appointments Update (Steve Chamberlain)

The Referee Appointments Officers both highlighted the ongoing concerns around the availability of referees being affected by clubs not confirming re-arranged kick off times earlier enough with match officials. It was emphasised that although teams could be flexible with kick off times (within the rules as they stand), they MUST communicate at that earliest available opportunity with both the league appointed match official and the League officers to ensure that everyone is aware of changes. It is not acceptable to only confirm kick off times and locations on a Thursday and expect the match official to be available and or the League to source a replacement at short notice. Working together and communication is the key.
